If you are aware of a course that you/your student may be failing, please review the following information. A failed course must be made up in a Summer School Program. The Scranton School District's Summer School Program will be held at **SCRANTON HIGH SCHOOL**, Scranton, PA.

If your report card indicates a failure in a major subject area AND/OR in Physical Education, then the failure of any major subject or gym class should be made up in summer school in order to ensure the requirements needed for graduation.

Your registration form for Scranton School District's Summer School Program is included and the course(s) needed are identified.

PLEASE FOLLOW THESE DIRECTIONS:

1) Cost for one course is \$110.00 plus a \$10.00, non-refundable, registration fee. All courses will be scheduled at **Scranton High School** during a six-week period from Tuesday, July 5, 2016 through Thursday, August 11, 2016, inclusive. Classes are 2 ½ hours, held Monday through Thursday, there are no Friday classes.

2) Cost for Physical Education is \$60.00 plus a \$5.00, non-refundable, registration fee. The length of

the course is 2 1/4 hours per day for a three-week period.

3.) Students MUST register on Tuesday, June 28 or Wednesday, June 29

at Scranton High School.

From 9AM to 12PM AND 1PM to 3PM Both days

Take your attached registration card with you when registering at Scranton High School. When you arrive please ask the hall monitor to direct you to the Summer School Office. Room assignments and times will be given to you at that time.

4) Please follow these directions. Failure to make up any course may result in not meeting

requirements for graduation. All passing grades will be transferred as a 70.
