2. At this point, our benchmarking for onsite students in math and reading is completed. We are attempting to benchmark virtual students through appointments. Progress reports for the mid-point of quarter 1 are being sent home at the present time.
3. 1st grade teachers took part in the MTSS training focusing on Enhancing Early Literacy Outcomes. This is a year long initiative focused on providing PD to teachers in the Science of Reading (SOR); identifying where, when and why our students struggle the most in terms of early reading skill acquisition and prevent/mitigate; and expanding/refining our continuum of evidence-based methodologies to better inform instructional decisions and interventions across and within the tiers. Using the Enhanced Core Reading instruction (ECRI) materials and routines in conjunction with our core ELA program and Foundations, this will allow us to develop an instructional program that is proactive and responsive to the needs of our students' population.

4. Kindergarten and 3rd grade teachers are taking part in LETRS training which began in August 2020 and will continue throughout the school year. This is a self-guided fully virtual professional development training that will be monitored by Mary Lou Heron from the NEIU and myself. LETRS(Language Essentials for Teachers of Reading and Spelling) focuses on providing all teachers with the skills they need to master the core components of reading instruction— phonological awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, comprehension, writing, and language (<https://www.voyagersopris.com/professional-development/letrs/letrs-k-12>).
