

Old Forge High School Principal Board Report

October 14, 2020

As of October 13, 2020 there are 446 students enrolled in the Old Forge Junior/Senior High School. 167 students are attending virtually, 141 students are attending on an A day schedule, 117 students are attending on a B day schedule, and 20 students are attending full time.

I held a One-to-One Chromebook Initiative information session on Tuesday, October 13th. We will begin distributing Chromebooks to all junior/senior high school students on Thursday, October 15th.

1st quarter progress reports were mailed home on Tuesday, October 6th. The 1st quarter is tentatively scheduled to end on Friday, November 6th.

Fall sports parent's night ceremonies will be conducted before the football game on Saturday, October 17th. Congratulation to all seniors and their parents!

Homecoming is tentatively scheduled for Friday, October 30th. The homecoming court will be announced at halftime and the king and queen will be crowned.

PSAT will be administered to all Sophomores and to Juniors who opt to take the exam on Thursday, October 29th. All students will attend classes virtually on this day and PSAT test takers will be in the building for the exam.

The Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency (PHEAA) held a virtual meeting on Thursday, October 8th to speak to junior and senior students and their parents about financial aid. They also conducted a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) workshop after the financial aid meeting for families of seniors that needed help filling out the application.

Peoples Security Bank in conjunction with The Foundry and Community Foundations, is offering scholarships for Lackawanna College's, Johnson College's and the University of Scranton's dual enrollment classes. Letters will be sent home to the parents/guardian of dual enrollment students in the coming weeks.
